VINTAGE NOTES

2020 growing season enjoyed a near-perfect growing conditions, an August heat spell accelerated ripening. The crop was expected to be smaller than average, producing smaller berries but . A mid-August lighting storm resulted in a dramatic turn for Sonoma County.

We at Tobias Glen feel so blessed to have weathered the relentless storm unscathed to shepherd another great vintage into barrels. The wines made in 2020 will be unforgettable.

TASTING NOTES

Nose: Intense and opulent, showing black cherry and warm spices

Palate: Soft layers of fruit followed by mineral and spices with underlying richness

Finish: Light footed and playful, reminiscent of Pommard with its grip and minerality
